

#### **Dear Parishioners and Friends**

Coming to Easter Sunday is like arriving at our destination after a long journey. If you are like me, Ash Wednesday was full of promise: yes, 'I'll start again; yes, a wonderful period for making a special effort; yes, I'll give up this, take up that. And I now look back and recognize lost opportunities and resolutions unfulfilled. But it's Easter! Time to put the past behind us and celebrate the present with joy and thanksgiving and look to the future with hope. After all, we are on a journey that, I certainly hope, will take longer than 6 weeks! Spiritual bags packed, the excitement of what lies ahead; and what company! A dead man now living, walking and travelling alongside us; and my fellow travellers skipping and dancing along the road despite the potholes!

Cardinal Bernadin (1928 – 1996) former archbishop of Chicago, reflected on Easter in similar but perhaps more theological terms: There are times in most of our lives when we feel entombed.
